An Environmental Education field study designed specifically for homeschoolers. Bring your family to the beach for an educational vacation at a great value. Our environmental education program teaches over 5,000 students every year. We have reserved space during these days in April for individual homeschool families to sign up directly with us.

Cost:

The cost for this 4-day field study package includes lodging, classes, and meals.

- Adults and students ages 6 and above: \$120 per person
- Children ages 3-5 are half price; 2 and under are free
- If you are staying off-site, the price is \$80 per person which includes all meals (\$60 includes the minimum number of meals—lunch and dinner on Monday and lunch on Tuesday)

Accommodations:

Our comfortable dormitories have heat, AC, and bathrooms (see pictures on our website). Each dorm has a separate chaperone room with private bathroom. Dorm space is very limited so I encourage you to sign up early. Groups of 5 or more at full price are guaranteed their own private dorm. If you have less than five in your family bring along another family you are friends with and share a dorm. You will have plenty of room--the dorms are spacious. There will also be limited shared dorm space for families of less than 5. Shared dorms will be partitioned so that 2 different families will share a dorm, each having their own bathroom. Another great option is to stay at a hotel, condo, house or campground on Tybee Island.

Classes:

See the schedule below for class listings and visit our website (www.burton4h.org) for detailed class descriptions. Students will be grouped with children of similar ages. Classes are designed for ages 5 through 17. Adults are expected to attend classes as well and help with supervision during your entire length of stay. Younger children are welcome to attend classes but should be under close parental supervision.

MAKE IT A TYBEE VACATION! Arrive early and spend the weekend enjoying Tybee Island. You can move into your dorm as early as Friday afternoon, April 16th. Each additional night in the dorm costs \$13 per person. Continental breakfast available on Saturday and Sunday morning for \$4. Sack lunch available for you to pack in your cooler Saturday and Sunday for \$4.50. Children ages 3-5: half price; 2 and under are free for all these prices. Advanced registration for these meals required.

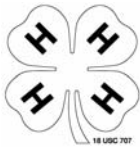
