Cost:

The cost for this 3-day field study package includes lodging, classes, and meals.

- Adults and students ages 6 and above: \$85 per person
- Children ages 3-5: \$43; 2 and under: free
- If you are staying off-site and do not require lodging, the price is \$65 per person (\$33 for age 3-5)

Accommodations:

Our comfortable dormitories have heat, AC, and bathrooms (see pictures on our website). Each dorm has a separate chaperone room with private bathroom. Groups of 5 or more at full price are guaranteed their own private dorm. If you have less than five in your family you can bring along another family you are friends with and share a dorm. Also, we will have one dorm reserved for moms or daughters and one for dads or sons. These two dorms will be right next to each other so you won't be far from the rest of your family. Another option is to stay at a hotel, condo, house or campground on Tybee Island.

Classes:

See the schedule below for class listings and visit our website for detailed class descriptions. Students will be grouped with children of similar ages. Classes are designed for ages 6 through 17. Adults are expected to attend classes as well and help with supervision during your entire length of stay. Younger children are welcome to attend classes but should be under close parental supervision.
