An Environmental Education field study designed specifically for homeschoolers. Bring your family to the beach for an educational vacation at a great value. Our environmental education program teaches over 5,000 students every year. We have reserved space during these days in September for individual homeschool families to sign up directly with us.

Cost:

The cost for these 3-day field study sessions includes lodging, classes, and meals.

- Adults and students ages 6 and above: \$80 per person
- Children ages 3-5 are half price; 2 and under are free
- If you are staying off-site, the price is \$58 per person which includes all meals and classes or \$45 per person for classes only no meals
- Stay for both sessions! There are different classes for each session.

Accommodations:

Our comfortable dormitories have heat, AC, and bathrooms (see pictures on our website). Each dorm has a separate chaperone room with private bathroom. Dorm space is very limited so I encourage you to sign up early. Groups of 5 or more (that is, 5 of age 3 and older) can have their own private dorm. If you have less than five bring along another family you are friends with and share a dorm. You will have plenty of room--the dorms are spacious and designed for about 20 people. There will also be limited shared dorm space for families of less than 5. Shared dorms will be partitioned down the middle so each family will have one side of the dorm. There will be a separate bathroom on each side. Another option is to stay at a hotel, condo, house or campground on Tybee Island.

Classes:

See the schedule below for class listings and visit our website (www.burton4h.org) for detailed class descriptions. Students will be grouped with children of similar ages. Classes are designed for ages 5 through 17. Adults are expected to attend classes as well and help with supervision during your entire length of stay. Younger children are welcome to attend classes but should be under close parental supervision.

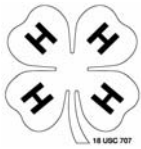

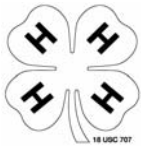
